**CLEANING / PAINTING:**

Offer to do Guesthouse spring-cleaning  
Paint hospital items such as IV poles, bedside tables, cabinets  
Clean screens & windows  
Draw/paint pictures/murals on hospital wards

**MAINTENANCE / LANDSCAPING:**

Carpentry – build tables, cabinets, shelves  
Assist with vehicle maintenance  
Small engine repair & maintenance  
Repair wheel chairs & other hospital equipment  
Clean hospital equipment  
Plant trees, flowers

**SEWING:**

Sew clothes for missionaries  
Sew/patch hospital items  
Sew holiday items for special celebrations

**PATIENT CARE & ENCOURAGEMENT:**

Hold babies on the pediatric ward  
Make balloon animals for kids in hospital  
Sing/play guitar on the various wards

**STAFF ENCOURAGEMENT:**

Visit staff in their homes  
Participate in the English Club

**MINISTRY:**

Present a devotional to staff  
Present a devotional to the patients & their families  
Accompany Chaplain on his rounds  
Share your personal testimony  
Present special music

**TEACHING:**

Teach missionary kids a special skill  
Teach handicrafts  
Teach VBS  
Teach English as a second language  
Tutor an individual in English

**CHILD CARE:**

Offer to care for missionary kids  
Do activities with the children – hikes, games
